From Principal Desk:

I feel privileged to undertake the pleasant duty of presenting the report of all the activities undertaken during the academic session 2023-2024.

About College: Govt. Degree College Indora came into existence in November 1995 materializing the dream of thousands of people from Indora Constituency and provided them an opportunity to end the darkness of ignorance of their children since everyone could not send their wards too far off places for higher education. The college started with 53 students in a five room building of Govt. Senior Secondary School Indora, but the seedling has now become a full grown tree with increasing enrolment every year. During its inception year, the college offered degree course in Arts only, but now besides UG courses in Commerce and Science and Arts, it is offering PGDCA, BCA, BBA and Post-Graduation in Mathematics with a total of 1085 students studying under these courses. Among them, there are 356 boys and 729 girls which clearly show that the girl students outnumber boys in this institution

Under Rashtriya Uchchttar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) a wide range of choices to opt the courses was introduced in the form of semester system in 2013-2014 and the same is in practice in recent annual system. We have enrolled students for Discipline Specific Courses in the subjects of: Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, Botany, Zoology, Economics, History, Hindi, Political Science, Public administration, Geography, Sociology, Vocal Music, English, and Commerce.

Our college is functioning in a three story building with six lecture theatres, twelve classrooms, and an examination hall. The college is well equipped with laboratories of all the

science subjects' i.e. Chemistry, Physics, Botany, Zoology and Geography, a Library, two Computer labs and three Smart classrooms. A CCTV monitoring system is also functional to ensure the security and safety of the college. The college has a well-equipped medical room with one bed and First Aid Material.

During the current year, developmental works include the renovation of Washrooms, maintenance of student desks, up gradation of equipments of Physics, Chemistry and Computer labs, Installation of iron frames in classrooms windows. The college also purchased sports equipments and track suits for the college sportspersons.

College Staff: Besides Principal, there are 23 sanctioned posts of teachers out of which nineteen are working on regular basis and three out of PTA fund and three are lying vacant
