


Student Feedback Analysis Report

Session- 2019-20

- 1. Depth of Course Content (Statement No. 1): An impressive 93.48% of respondents rated the depth of course content, including practicals, as excellent. Only 6.52% considered it very good, with no good, average, or poor ratings.
- 2. Extent of Coverage and Time Allotted (Statement No. 2): Approximately 73.37% rated the coverage and time allocation for the course as excellent. Another 26.63% found it very good, indicating overall satisfaction. No good, average, or poor ratings were reported.
- 3. Division and Sequence of Units in the Syllabus (Statement No. 3): The division and sequence of units received positive feedback. 68% rated it excellent, and 31.52% found it very good. Only 0.54% gave it a lower rating.
- 4. Repeat Query on Unit Division and Sequence (Statement No. 4): While 57.61% still rated it excellent, there was an increase in very good ratings (41.3%). Only 1.09% considered it good, with no average or poor ratings.
- 5. Timely Coverage of Syllabus (Statement No. 5): Over 70.11% rated timely syllabus coverage as excellent. However, 29.89% gave it a very good rating, indicating some concerns. No good, average, or poor ratings were reported.
- 6. Availability of Text/Reference Books (Statement No. 6): Availability of books in the market received mixed feedback. m61.18% rated it excellent, but 37.5% found it very good. A small percentage (1.63%) gave it a lower rating.
- 7. Availability of Syllabus-Based E-Resources (Statement No. 7): Similar to text/reference books, syllabus-based e-resources had positive feedback. 65.76% rated it excellent, while 33.7% found it very good. A minor percentage (0.54%) gave it a lower rating:
- 8. Inclusion of Latest Developments (Statement No. 8): The inclusion of latest developments in the subject received mixed feedback. 68.48% rated it excellent, and 30.98% found it very good. Only 0.54% gave it a lower rating.
- 9. Allocation of Credits to Courses (Statement No. 9): Credit allocation was well-received. 73.37% rated it excellent, and 25.54% found it very good. A minor percentage (1.09%) gave it a lower rating.
- 10. Evaluation Scheme Design (Statement No. 10): The evaluation scheme for each course had positive feedback. 71.2% rated it excellent, while 27.72% found it very good. A small percentage (0.54%) gave it an average rating.

Overall, the course seems to excel in several areas, but there are opportunities for improvement.



 - 7. Availability of Syllabus-Based E-Resources: Positive feedback (65.76% excellent, 33.7% very good) will guide efforts to expand digital resources and enhance accessibility to support diverse learning needs effectively.
 - 8. Inclusion of Latest Developments: While 68.48% rated the inclusion of latest developments as excellent and 30.98% as very good, strategies will focus on integrating cutting-edge advancements more comprehensively across
