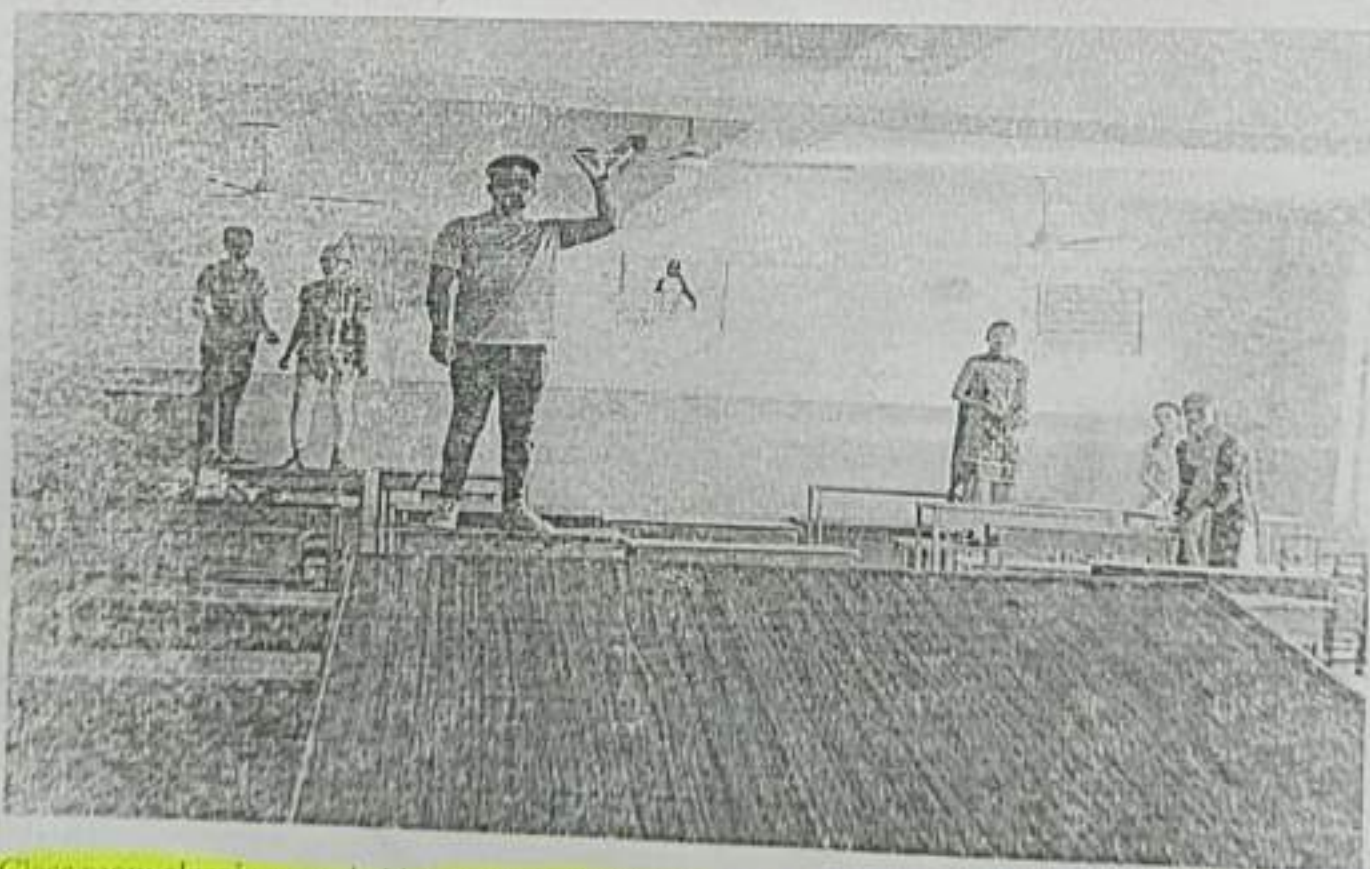

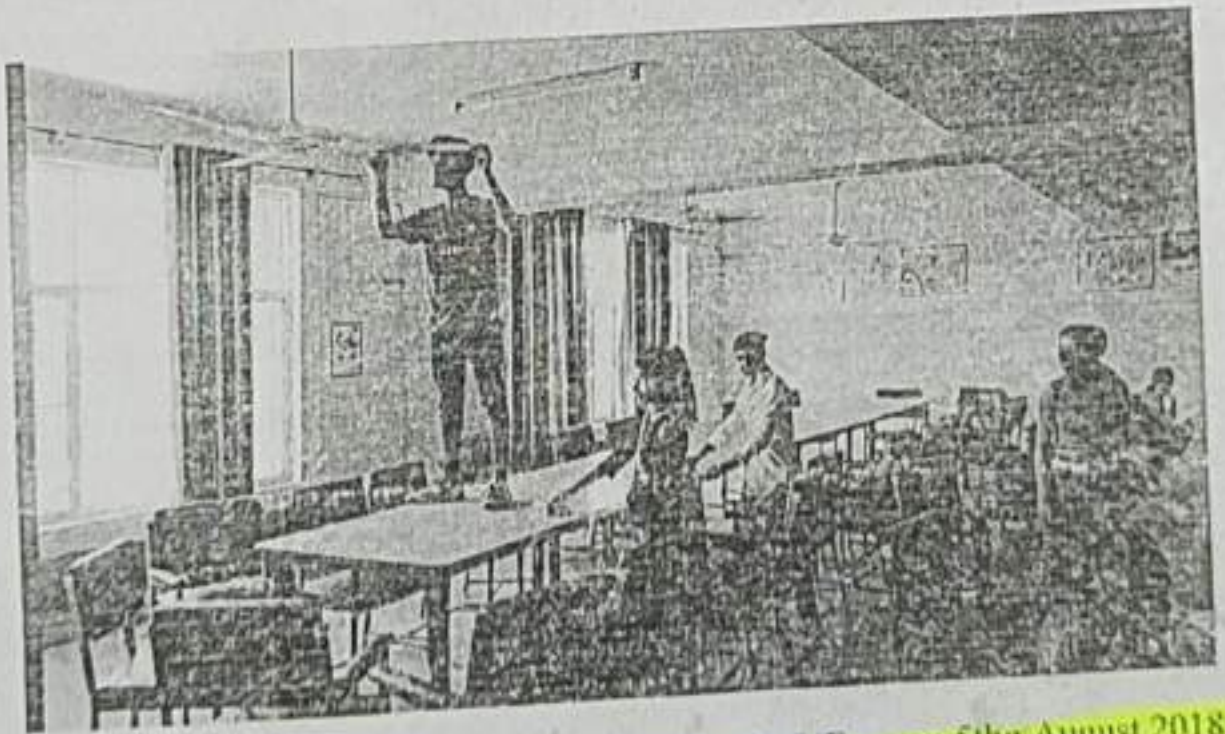

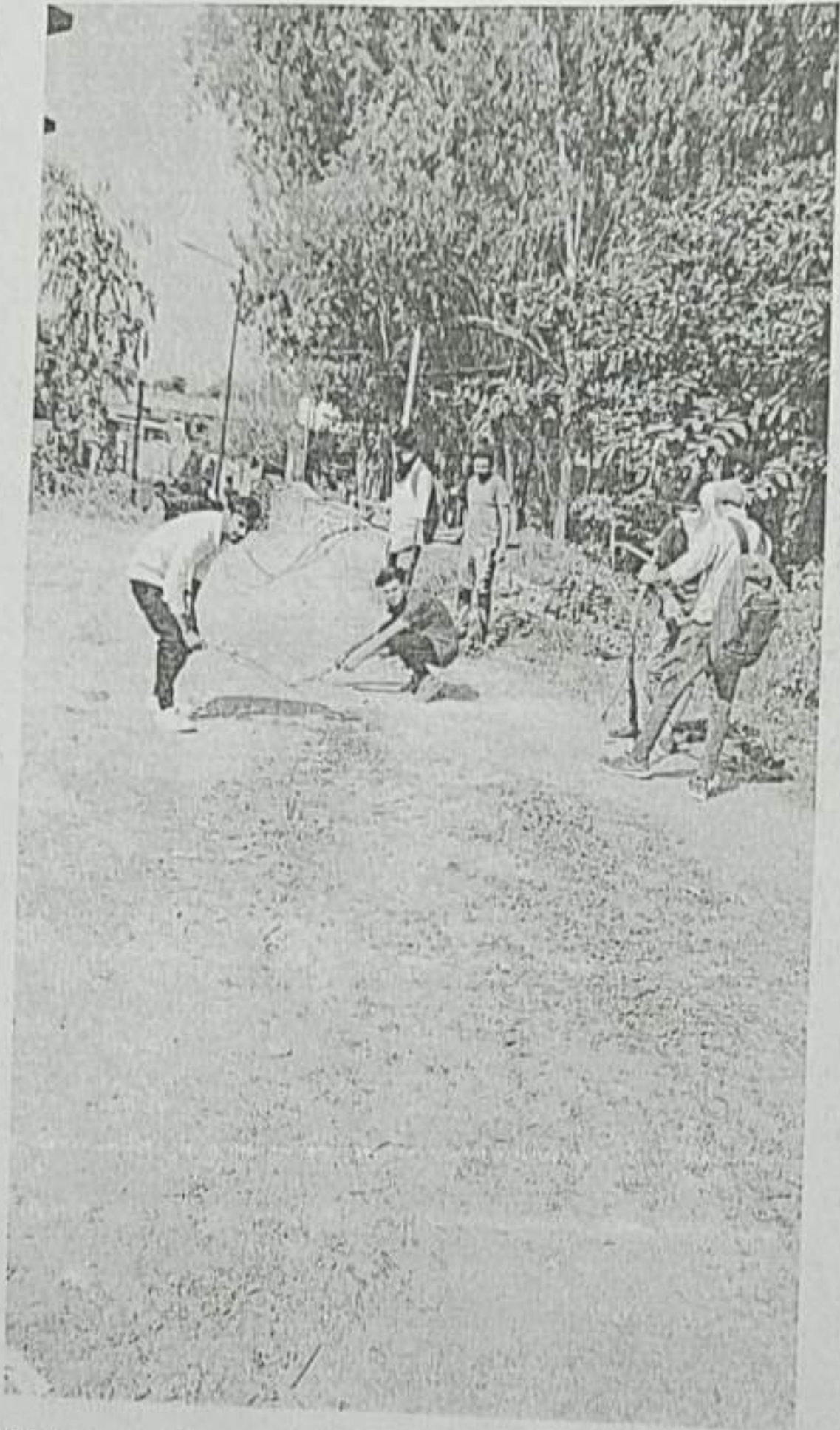

05.01.2019 on the 5th day of the special camp cleanliness drive was organized at Govt. College Indore.



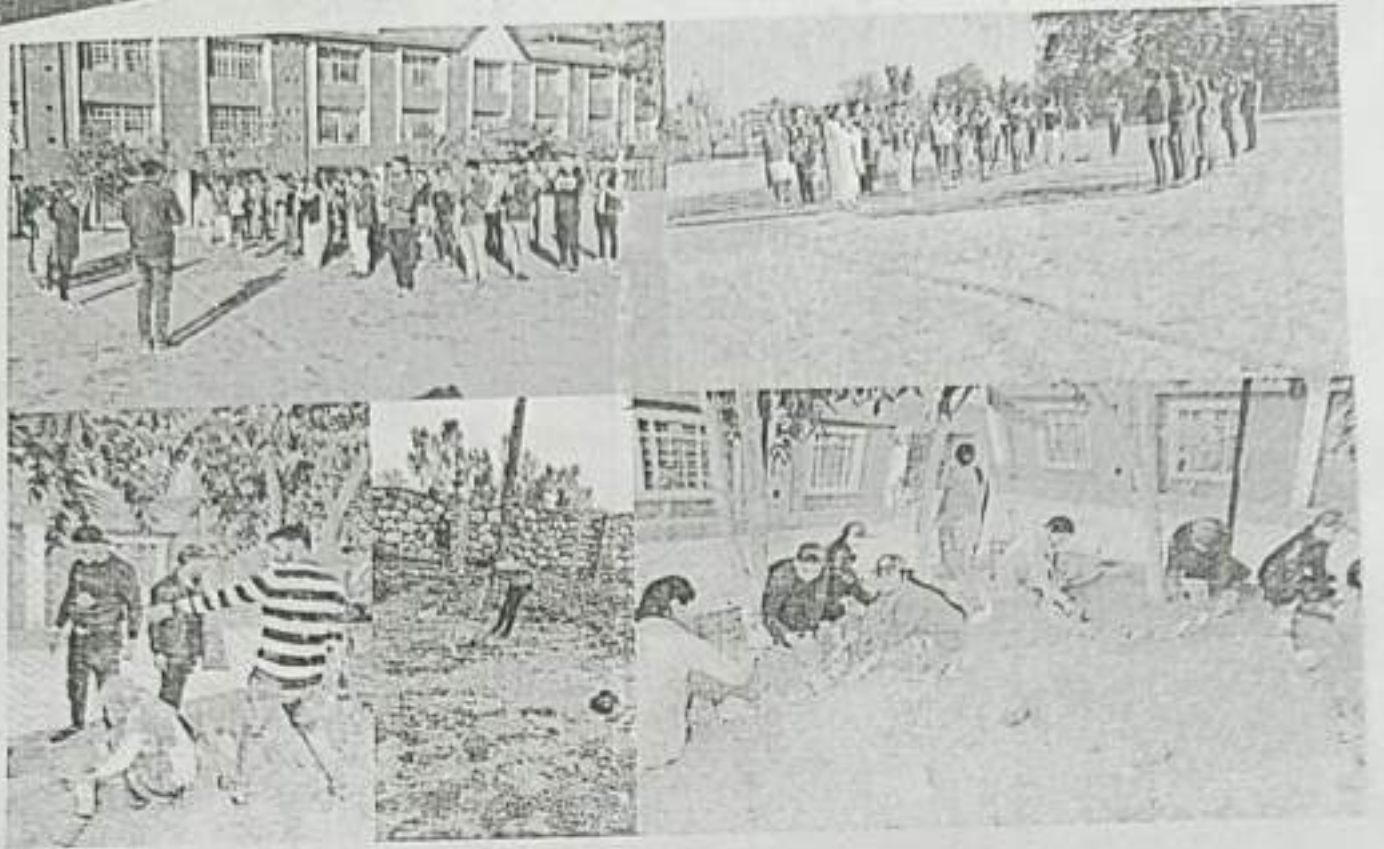
