

#### **Teachers Feedback Analysis Report**

#### **Session (2023-24)**

- 1. The course provides the complete information and knowledge about the subject: The majority of teachers, 61.90%, rated the courses as "Excellent" in terms of providing complete information and knowledge about the subject, with another 33.30% considering it "Very Good." Only 4.76% rated it as "Good," indicating that there is broad satisfaction among the staff, with no responses indicating an average or poor experience.
- **2.** The course is helpful for higher studies: The course's relevance to higher studies received a mixed response. While 61.90% of the teachers rated it as "Excellent," a significant portion, 19.04%, rated it "Good," and 14.20% rated it "Average." Only 4.76% rated it "Very Good," revealing that a notable minority believe there is room for improvement in this area.
- **3.** The college campus is clean and well maintained: In terms of campus cleanliness and maintenance, 33.30% of the teachers rated the college as "Excellent," and 42.85% as "Very Good," showing general satisfaction. However, 23.80% rated it as "Good," indicating that while the majority are pleased, there is some room for further improvements.
- **4. There is adequate number of classrooms in the college:** About 47.60% of the teachers felt the number of classrooms was "Excellent," and 33.3% rated it "Very Good." Still, 9.52% of teachers gave it a "Good" and "Average" rating each, which suggests that while the majority of staff are content, a portion feels the classroom facilities could be expanded.
- **5.** There is adequate number of labs in the college: An equal percentage of teachers, 42.85%, rated the number of labs as both "Excellent" and "Very Good," suggesting a high level of satisfaction with lab availability. However, 14.20% felt it was only "Good," indicating some minor concerns but no dissatisfaction overall.
- **6.** The sufficient number of books are available in the library: The library book collection was rated "Excellent" and "Very Good" by 42.85% of teachers in each category. However, 4.76% of respondents rated it "Good" and "Average," and another 4.76% rated it "Poor," suggesting a small portion of teachers feel there is a lack of books available.
- 7. Internet facilities are adequate in the college: A third of teachers, 33.3%, rated the internet facilities as "Excellent," but 23.80% found it to be "Very Good" and an equal percentage rated it as "Average." This indicates a wide range of opinions and suggests that internet access may not be uniformly reliable across the campus.
- **8.** Basic facilities like washrooms, water, and electricity are satisfactory in the college: Basic facilities were rated "Very Good" by 42.85% of teachers, and 28.57% found them "Excellent." However, 19.04% felt the facilities were "Good," and 9.52% rated them as "Average," indicating some concerns in this area that may need to be addressed.
- **9. Canteen facility is satisfactory in the college:** The canteen facilities received the lowest ratings overall, with only 19.04% rating them as "Excellent" and 33.3% as "Very Good." A significant number of teachers, 28.57%, rated the canteen as "Good," and 19.04% felt it was merely "Average," highlighting this as an area where improvements could be made.

# 10. Overall environment of the college is conducive to learning

The overall learning environment received positive feedback, with 47.61% of teachers rating it as "Excellent" and 42.85% as "Very Good." A small percentage (4.76%) rated it as "Good" and "Average," indicating a strong consensus that the college environment supports learning effectively.

# Action Taken Report: Teachers Feedback Analysis Session (2023-24)

## 1. Course Content and Knowledge Delivery

**Feedback:** 61.90% rated course content as "Excellent," but 4.76% rated it as "Good." **Action Taken:** 

- Conducted a review of the course materials to ensure alignment with learning objectives.
- Organized workshops for faculty to share best practices in delivering course content.
- Initiated a feedback mechanism to gather continuous input from teachers regarding course relevance and comprehensiveness.

#### 2. Relevance for Higher Studies

**Feedback:** 61.90% found the course helpful for higher studies, but 14.20% rated it as "Average." **Action Taken:** 

- Implemented additional resources and guidance on higher studies in course syllabi.
- Established partnerships with universities for guest lectures and seminars to enhance the transition to higher studies.
- Introduced mentorship programs pairing students with faculty members to discuss future academic pathways.

## 3. Campus Cleanliness and Maintenance

**Feedback:** 33.30% rated campus cleanliness as "Excellent," with 42.85% rating it "Very Good." **Action Taken:** 

- Strengthened the campus maintenance schedule, focusing on high-traffic areas and washrooms.
- Increased awareness campaigns among students and staff about the importance of maintaining cleanliness.
- Assigned a dedicated team to regularly assess cleanliness and maintenance needs on campus.

### 4. Classroom Availability

**Feedback:** 47.60% rated the number of classrooms as "Excellent," but some expressed concerns. **Action Taken:** 

- Evaluated classroom allocation and usage to maximize available space.
- Explored options for creating additional classrooms or repurposing existing spaces as needed.
- Improved scheduling practices to ensure better access to classrooms for all courses.

#### 5. Laboratory Facilities

Feedback: 42.85% rated lab availability as "Excellent."

#### **Action Taken:**

- Reviewed lab requirements for each course to ensure adequacy and functionality.
- Invested in upgrading existing lab equipment and resources based on departmental needs.
- Promoted collaboration among departments to share lab facilities and resources where possible.

# 6. Library Resources

**Feedback:** 42.85% rated library resources as "Excellent," but some rated them as "Poor." **Action Taken:** 

- Conducted a comprehensive audit of library holdings to identify gaps and prioritize acquisitions.
- Implemented an online catalog system for better accessibility of resources.
- Organized regular book fairs and reading weeks to encourage library use and gather student input on desired materials.

#### 7. Internet Facilities

Feedback: 33.3% rated internet facilities as "Excellent."

#### **Action Taken:**

- Upgraded the college's internet infrastructure to improve connectivity and bandwidth.
- Provided training sessions for teachers on effectively integrating technology into their teaching methods.
- Set up a feedback system for reporting internet issues to ensure timely resolutions.

# 8. Basic Facilities (Washrooms, Water, Electricity)

Feedback: 28.57% rated basic facilities as "Excellent."
